Accessing Oracle Account

To Access Oracle account from any CCC machine, follow these steps:

- 1) Execute the following command that will set the Oracle environment variables:

```
> source /usr/local/bin/oraenv
```

Otherwise, you can set the Oracle variables manually as follow:

```
ORACLE_BASE=/usr/local/oracle11gr2
```

```
ORACLE_HOME=/usr/local/oracle11gr2/product/11.2.0/db_1
```

```
ORACLE_SID=WPI11GR2
```

- 2) To connect to Oracle, use command:

```
> sqlplus <username>@@WPI11GR2
```

- 3) Your password is your username capitalized. After your first login change the password using the following command.

```
Sql > alter user <username> identified by <new_password>;
```
