### Accessing Oracle Account

To Access Oracle account from any CCC machine, follow these steps:

- 1) Open the command prompt window from a CCC machine
- 2) Execute the following command that will set the Oracle environment variables:  
**> source /usr/local/bin/oraenv**

Otherwise, you can set the Oracle variables manually as follow:

```
ORACLE_BASE=/usr/local/oracle11gr2
ORACLE_HOME=/usr/local/oracle11gr2/product/11.2.0/db_1
ORACLE_SID=WPI11GR2
```

- 3) To connect to Oracle, use command:  
**> sqlplus <username>@[@WPI11GR2](#)**

**\*\*Note:** if your username has a "." (For example, "ABC.XYZ"), then replace the "." with "\_" (So it will be "ABC\_XYZ").

- 4) Your password is your username capitalized. After your first login change the password using the following command.  
**Sql > alter user <username> identified by <new\_password>;**
