It is important for applicants to understand that the Instructor position is a three-part job at EXPLO: teacher, advisor, and leader. On a typical day, an Instructor will spend approximately 3 hours teaching in a classroom setting and the rest of the day and evening supervising all aspects of student life: from helping students bus meals in the cafeteria to leading afternoon activities, taking attendance at check-in and living group events, and chaperoning an evening event. Whatever students are involved in at EXPLO, our Instructors are involved in, too – helping to ensure that every moment of the day can be a learning moment and, most importantly, that every child is safe; physically, intellectually, and emotionally.
